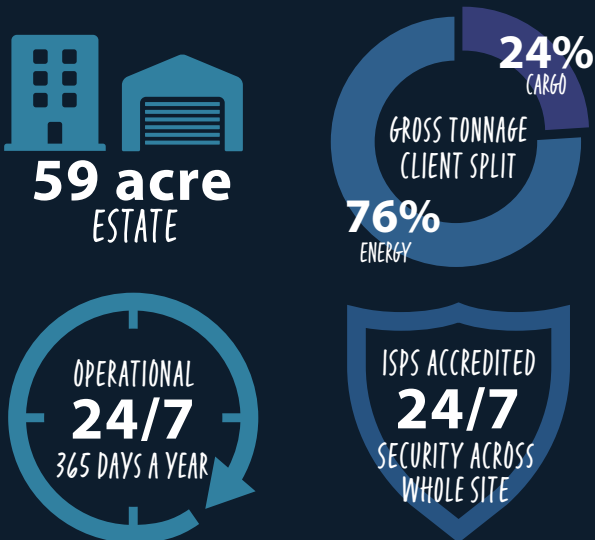

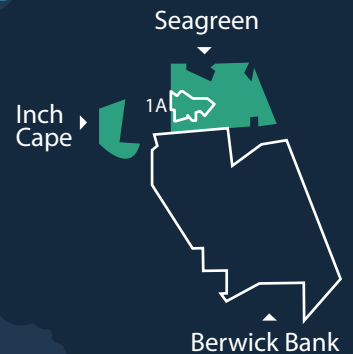

With 2.5GW capacity being operated from Montrose Port, we aspire to be of the largest Operational & Maintenance bases for offshore wind energy globally.

In 2022 we secured the Inch Cape O&M base with construction commencing in 2023.

In addition, we monitor our air and noise pollution levels frequently, and all our vehicle fleet and plant machinery operates on HVO fuel, reducing our emissions.
